The Clerk was asked to chase enforcement regarding the development of agricultural barns, an item that was raised May 2019

The market square was discussed and the Clerk was asked to speak to the owner of the Kings Head to ask them to keep clean and tidy

Cllr Lister discussed the tipping of soil waste to the north of Cam Lodge, the Clerk confirmed this was not a matter for the Parish Council on private land and no complaints had been received of parishioners.

The Clerk was asked for a police presence on school road for speeding. The Clerk confirmed that due to the current national situation the police presence in the Dale was at a peak.

It was advised that the Parish Council maybe asked to place social distancing measures in the village at some point in the future.

the Clerk was asked to draw up an action list of previous items for Councillors to review. It was advised the work at the stepping stones would be carried out imminently in Kettlewell and Starbotton and there was a new pathway created in the Church yard which was a great improvement.
